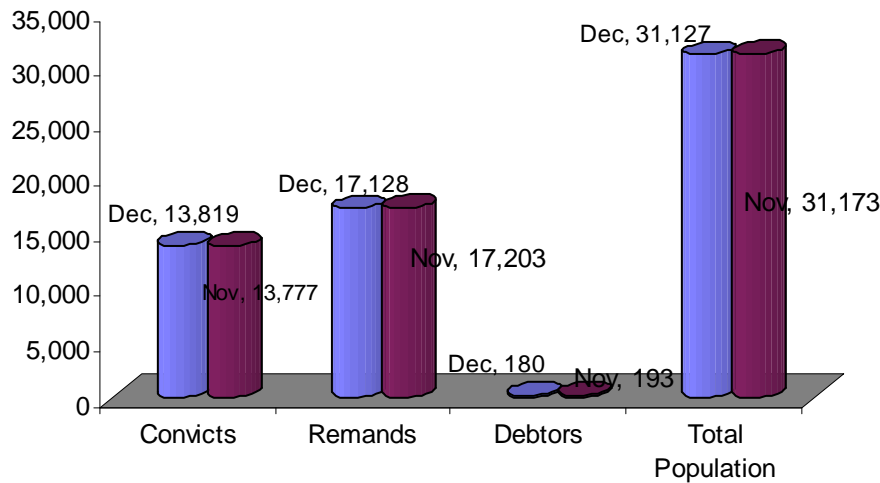

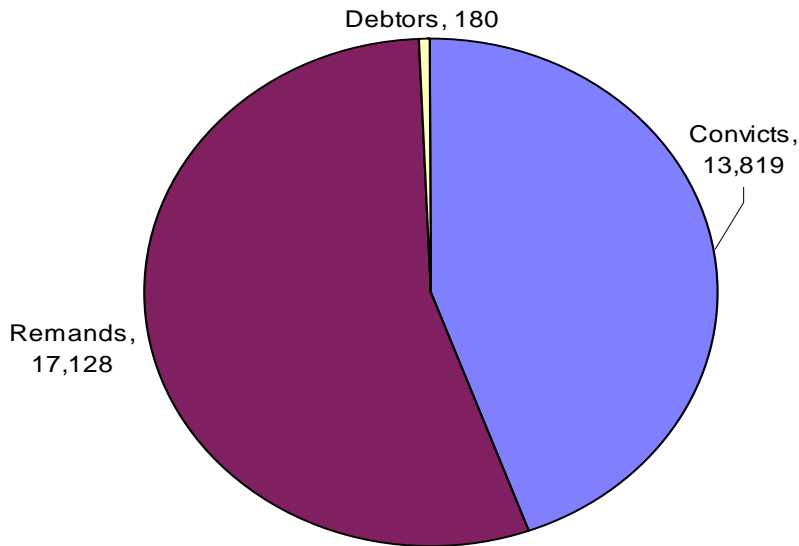

Figure1: Population for December, 2009 as compared to November.



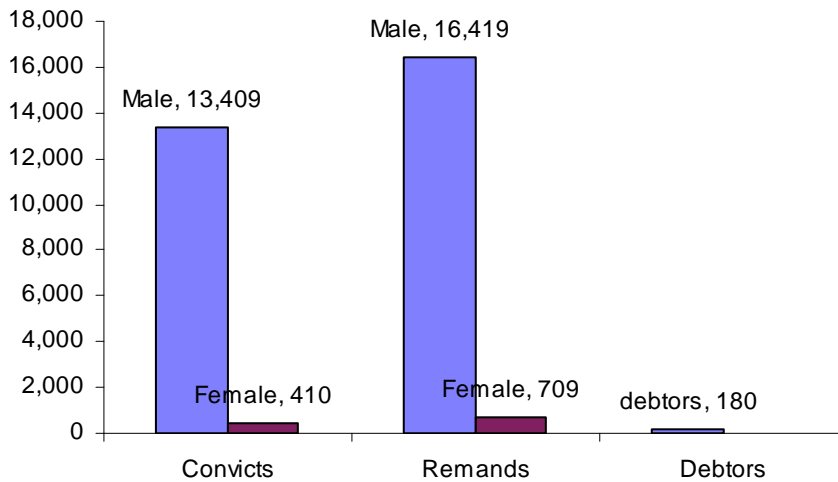
- i. Compared to the previous month of November, the overall average population decreased by 0.1% with an absolute decrease of **46** prisoners. There was a increase in convicted prisoners 0.3% absolute 42 , Remand prisoners decreased by 0.4% absolute decrease of **75**, Debtors decrease by 7.7% absolute decrease of **13** prisoners *as shown in the table above.*

- ii. Prisoners on remand made up the majority (55.0%) with an absolute value of **17,128** prisoners of which 96% (**16,419**) are male remands and 4% (**709**) are female remands, followed by convicted prisoners (44.4%) absolute value of **13,819**, where 97% (**13,409**) are male convicts and 3.0% (**410**) female convicts and the minority are debtors 0.6% absolute value of (**180**) prisoners. Overall, most of the prisoners in custody are males (**95.8%**) absolute value of **29,828** followed by females (**3.6%**) absolute value of **1,119** prisoners and minority are debtors **0.6%** absolute value of **180** prisoners.

The most congested region as per 31st December, 2009 was **South western** region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Rukungiri (587%), Kakiika (480%) Bushenyi (458%) & Ndorwa (431%) Mbarara (318%) and the small units Ntungamo & Kiruhura.

Northern region. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Loro (403%), Gulu (385%), Lira (383%), Patiko (200%) Apac (271%), among the small units the most congested was Patongo, Arocha, Kwania & Kitgum. For purposes of decongestion, convict inmates can be transferred to less congested penal units like Pece, Alebtong prisons.

Western region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Rukooki (263%), Ibuga (297%), F/portal prison (216%), Kibiito (444%), Kamwenge (606%), Mubuku (120%)

Southern region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region was Masaka prison (346%), Muinaina (285%) Mutukula (241%), among the small units Masaka ssaza, Kyanamukaka, Kassanda.

Kampala Extra region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Upper prison (350%), Kampala(R) (312%), Luzira(W) (289%), MBay (136%).

North Western region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Ragem prison (625%), Arua (273%) & Gilgil (235%), Adjumani (128%) among the small units Paidha (351%) , Koboko (245%) ,Lobule.

Central region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Kigo prison (268%) Nakasongola (163%), Bungungu YO (145%) among the small units Butuntumura, Buwambo, & Muduma.

North Eastern region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Amita (606%), Kotido (385%), Namalu (184%), Katakwi (505%) For purpose of decongestion convict inmates can be transferred to less congested penal units like Moroto (60%),

South Eastern region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Bufulubi prison (228%), Jinja (M) (245%), Jinja (R) (196%), Kamuli (200%), among the small units Kakiira, Kaiti, Kigandalo

Eastern region as seen in table above. Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Kumi (518%), Mbale(M) (134%), among the small units the most congested

were Mutufu (731%), Masafu (457%), Agule (600%). For purposes of decongestion, convict inmates can be transferred to less congested penal units like Tororo prison (71%), Soroti (82%), Ngora (44%), Mukuju prisons (38%).

****Mid Western-** accommodation capacity for most units in this region is not known.

Among the big units the most congested penal institutions in this region were Masindi(M) (307%), Isimba (191%), among the small units the most congested was Kagadi (144%).

- iii. There is still overall congestion in most prisons as seen in *table below pg 1&2* (look at occupancy %).
- iv. The total approved prisons capacity in the country for the big units is **9933** and small units **provided** is **3737 total 13,670**. This therefore means there is an excess over capacity of 127.7% with an absolute value of 17,457 prisoners.

NB: It's advisable that management pursues the issue of taking measurements (holding capacities) for all penal institutions throughout the country. This will go a long way to improve on planning for all the 222 units as a well as addressing the Human rights issues arising from over congestion.

***** New measurements were taken for recently constructed or renovated prisons and this has brought about a change in the accommodation capacities.***
